JSA Essentials

- List the Job to be analyzed
- Break the job down into primary steps
- For each job step, list the identified hazard (s)
- For each identified hazard, list mitigation method (s)
- JSA should be written at the work site
- Discussion should be facilitated, not dictated.
- Baseline JSA's can be developed for routine jobs
- Baseline JSA's should include room for variables such as weather and simultaneous operations
- Long jobs should be discussed one phase at a time
